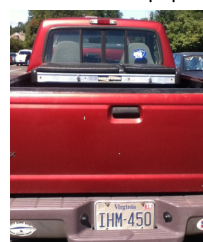
## More Lap Blankets Are Needed for "911 Dispatchers That Care"
