I discovered WPRZ on my car radio by... what I thought was an... accident. I became a loyal listener learning so much and learning so much and falling in love with Contemporary Christian Music. I heard the station had a need for volunteers and wanted so badly to give back to a station who "fed" me every day. I work a full-time job with rotating shifts, on-call hours, have a husband and two teenage kids with busy schedules and wondered how in the world I would ever find the time.
